Regulating the Crypto Economy: Business Transformation and Financialisation

The book by Chiu focuses on the building of a crypto economy as an alternative economic space and discusses how the crypto economy should be governed. The author argues that it is imperative for regulatory policy to develop the economic governance of the blockchain-based business model, in order to facilitate economic mobilisation and wealth creation. The regulatory framework should cater for a new and unique enterprise organisational law and the fund-raising and financing of blockchain-based development projects. The author advances the message that an innovative regulatory agenda is needed to account for the economically disruptive and technologically transformative developments brought about by the crypto economy.
